PSA - Public Service Announcement - you will create a movie that uses still images and

words, either typed or spoken, that will move your audience to action. Your PSA will be created in school using WeVideo and will be between 20 - 40 seconds long.

The Message of my PSA is:

Storyboard your PSA - this must be completed before you sit at a computer to create your video. The Image boxes describe what we will see on the screen - this will be what you will look for in Google images. In the text boxes, type out what you will say over the image or will type on the screen. If you are going to type words, it works best to have a colored background, not an image - it is difficult to read words and absorb the message from the image at the same time. Also, you will want to limit the number of words spoken or typed for each image.

PSA Storyboard - the number of images will vary

Images

After you have finished your plan (storyboard) you will now look for your images in google image search. When you find an image you like, click on it, click on view image and copy and paste the url into your storyboard in the box with the description.

Then **right click on the image and choose save to google drive** - this will put the picture into

google drive for uploading to wevideo later. Do this for all your images.

Wevideo

When you are done saving urls into your storyboard and right clicking and saving to google drive it is now time to use Wevideo. Go to your apps list and click on wevideo, under your name click join network and type the code Mrs. Wright gives you.

Click new project, name it Health PSA, and then click create video.
